The HealthNet PGY1 Community-based Residency Program in affiliation with Purdue University will provide the resident a unique opportunity to work on an interdisciplinary team in the care of underserved patients. Collaborative practice agreements are in place for pharmacists to initiate and/or adjust medications for diabetes, COPD, asthma, hypertension, HIV, tobacco cessation, anticoagulation and GERD. The resident will actively participate in building new services in a relatively new environment, with opportunities to improve upon existing and pilot new patient care services. The resident will also work directly with a Family Nurse Practitioner as she provides medical care to patients participating in HealthNet's Homeless Initiative Program on-site at a shelter. The resident will have the opportunity for networking and shared learning through joint participation with other Purdue-affiliated Community-based residents in a formal research project development discussion series, a business plan development series and a teaching certificate program (IPTeC).

WHAT IS A CAREER FAIR?

A Career Fair is a professional recruiting event during which various employers seek out prospective employees for their companies. Career fairs are a fantastic opportunity for students to learn about different industries and grow their professional network. They also help recruiters identify and hire promising students.

Preparing for event

Research Employers/Organizations Attending - Before attending a career fair, know which companies you want to talk to. While researching companies you are interested in, learn about their mission and future goals. If it's posted online, you could research the specific position you are looking for as well. Share what you have learned with recruiters when speaking to them and come up with tailored, genuine questions. These steps show that you've spent extra time getting to know the company beforehand and want to work for them.

Elevator Pitch - An elevator pitch is a 30-second speech that is a great way to introduce yourself and start a conversation with a recruiter. Add your name, background information, and career interests to your elevator pitch. Be yourself and make sure to highlight your interests and uniqueness. If you want to go above and beyond, tailor your elevator pitch to each company you visit at the fair by including interests within the company's sphere of influence. Try to practice with a friend or in front of a mirror before coming.

Day of the event

Relax, eat, and drink water - You have so much to offer, so take the time to care for yourself.

Get There on Time – Allow yourself plenty of time at the fair to ask questions and gather information

What to Bring – Bringing copies of your CV or resume is never a bad idea even if companies have an electronic submission option. Also, having a pen to write down questions or information is always helpful. Lastly, bringing all of this in a professional-looking folder, notebook, or padfolio is a great way to consolidate your material and store business cards and information from companies.

Get Contact Information - When talking to a recruiter, ask for their business card or LinkedIn. Be sure to ask them questions that are relevant to them and the company they represent. Learn about why they joined their company and what they look for in prospective employees.

Take Chances - There will be over 50 companies at this year's Career Fair. There may be companies you have never heard of but are perfect for. Take a chance on some of them. Talk to a recruiter even if you feel you may be underqualified for a position or company. You never know what they are looking for.

Practice – Before going up to companies you really want to talk to, first go and talk to other recruiters to get the jitters out. This will help you polish your elevator pitch, learn how to ask questions, and what the general flow of talking with a recruiter is like. It never hurts to get warmed up.

After the event

Follow Up - Recruiters talk to hundreds of students each year, and it can be challenging for them to remember each one. Try to get the recruiter's contact information and reach out to them after the fair. Show that you are still interested in the role and the company. Even if you do not receive an interview, try to stay in touch with them. Recruiters are more likely to hire people they recognize or are comfortable with. Sending a thank-you email is an excellent starting point.

Interviews - The interview is your chance to show recruiters your personality and skills. Think of the interview as a conversation between you and the recruiter. Interviewers typically use the "S.T.A.R. Method" to gather relevant information about the specific capabilities that the job requires. Often, you will be asked to describe a scenario that highlights your problem-solving abilities. Try to think ahead and prepare a few example scenarios.
